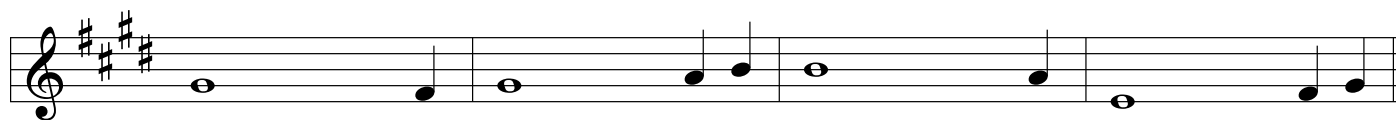


Sunday between 10 July and 16 July (Proper 15)
