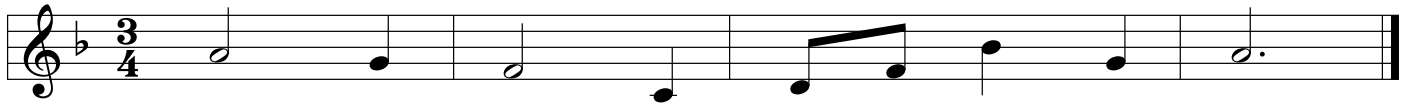


# All Saints (Year A)
