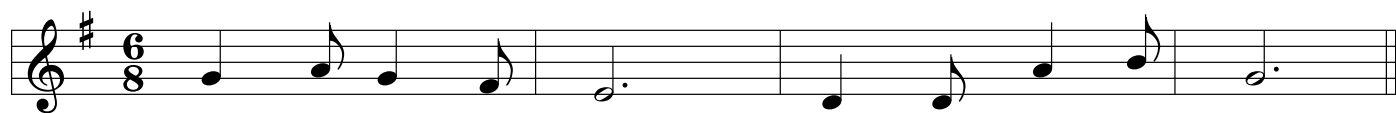
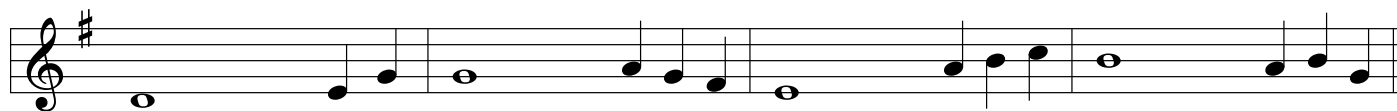


Fourth Sunday after the Epiphany (Proper 4)
