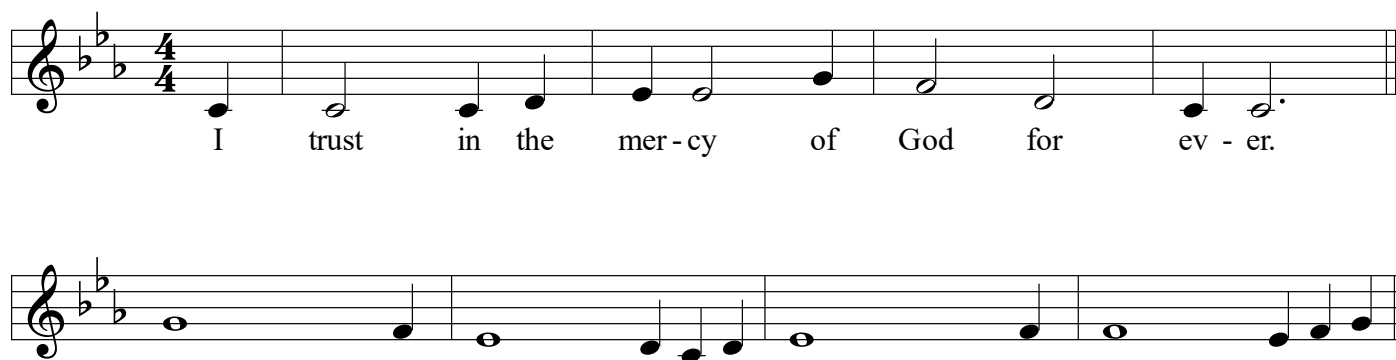


Sunday between 17 July and 23 July (Proper 16)
