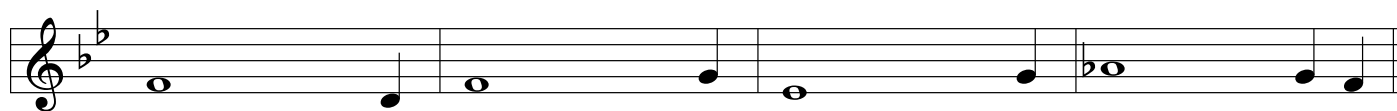
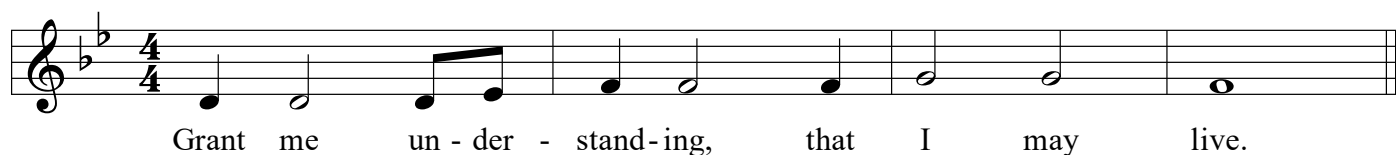


Sunday between 30 October and 5 November (Proper 31)
