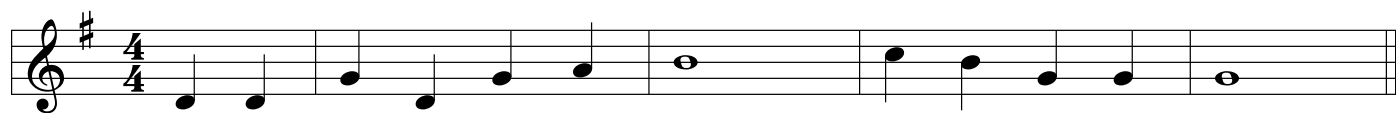
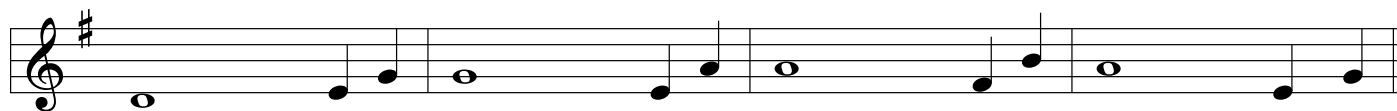


The Last Sunday after Pentecost: The Reign of Christ (Proper 34-T)
