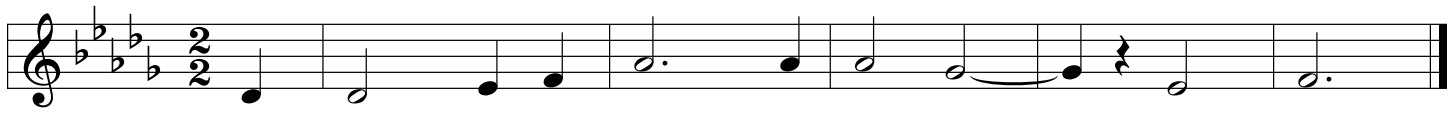
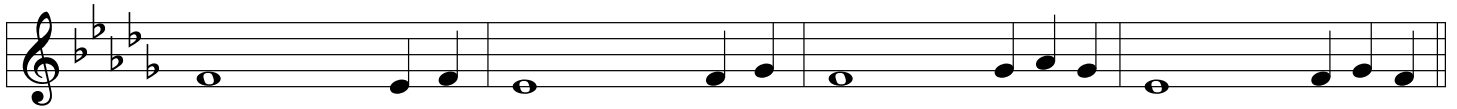


Sunday between 25 September and 1 October (Proper 26-T)
